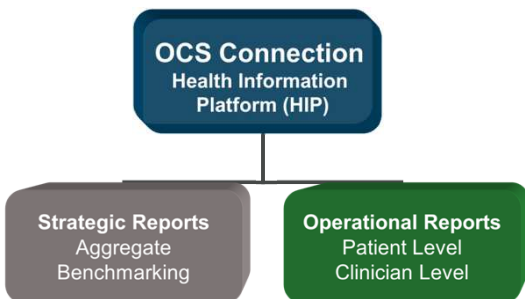

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OCS Roadmap Strategic vs. Operational



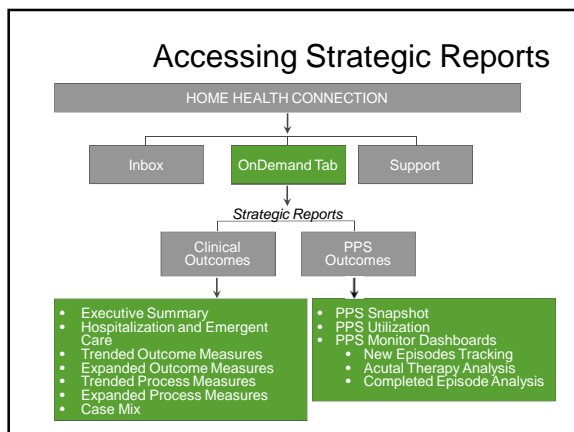

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PPS Snapshot

Q: What is the definition for overall average contribution per episode?

A: Average contribution is profit per episode.

- We calculate the adjusted case weight for a patient, then calculate the visit costs (based on cost data we get from CMS) and subtract the two. That gives us the margin for that PPS episode for that patient.
- Then we average the contribution for all episodes that ended during the time frame the user selects in the report.
- $\text{Reimbursement} - \text{Cost} = \text{Contribution (Profit)}$



PPS Snapshot

Q: What is the definition for average margin per episode?

A: Margin is similar to contribution, but turned into a percentage. We take the contribution and divide by the reimbursement amount for an episode to get the profit margin (ROI).

- Then we average the margin for all episodes that ended during the time frame the user selects in the report
- $\text{Contribution/Reimbursement} = \text{Margin (\%)}$

PPS Snapshot

Q: What does the average NRS add-on payment mean?

A: NRS is non-routine supplies

- The HHRG grouper methodology also calculates a reimbursement for certain HHRGs that assumes the patient will need supplies that are above and beyond the cost of standard supplies accounted for in the episode base payment.
- Here, OCS has calculated the non-routine supply add-on for each episode and averaged it for all episodes.

Strategic Reports

Q: When is my June data available on the report Strategic Reports (like the Trended Outcomes)?

A: The June drop down option will appear the 1st day of the following month – July

A: Last release of Blackout Reports

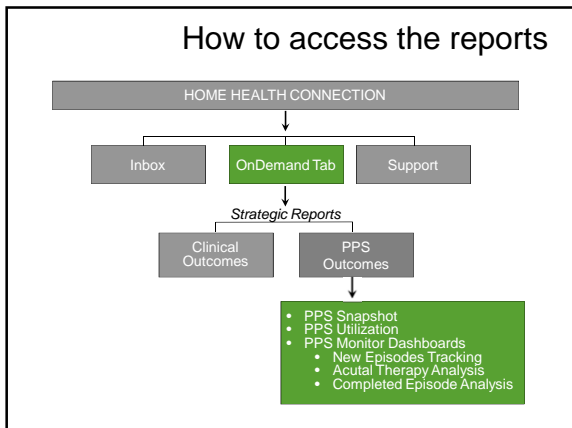

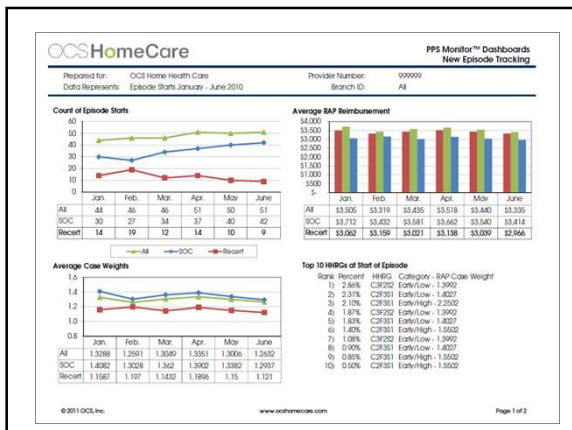


Blackout Report Replacement
